**Responsibilities:**

- Develop lecture materials (support will be available for lecture development)
- Engage with residents to conduct a minimum of two didactic activities in a year. Through either interactive case-based learning, interactive reviews of journal article(s), teaching a topic as a presentation, and/or practice of exam style questions.

**Qualification Requirements:**

- Psychiatrist, Psychologist, Master of Social Work (MSW), Registered Psychotherapist, or Physician with a background in emergency medicine, family medicine, pediatrics, pain or sleep management.
- Passionate about mental health education.
- Detail oriented, self-directed, and organized with strong time-management skills.
- Experience teaching at the post-secondary level considered an asset.
- Ability to teach at least one of the following subjects;
  - Mood, anxiety and/or substance use disorders
  - Psychotherapy in general and specific approaches like Supportive Psychotherapy, CBT, DBT, Interpersonal therapy, Family focused therapy, Motivational interviewing etc.
  - Psychosis and related illnesses
  - Pervasive Developmental disorders and Autism
  - Childhood behavioral disorders
  - Reactive attachment disorder and childhood trauma
  - Suicide risk assessment and crisis management
  - Personality disorders, assessment and management
  - Psycho-somatic illnesses
  - Sleep disorders
